The last long weekend in Spain of 2022 in celebration of the Spanish Constitution and the Immaculate Conception is an opportunity for one last getaway, and what better place to get away to than Lanzarote, Majorca or Cadiz, three warm weather destinations offered up by Hipotels Hotels & Resorts.

Lanzarote, a volcanic island with a Martian landscape and abundant cultural offerings, boasts pleasant temperatures of around 22° on average. Among the options are visits to the famous Yaiza Nativity Scene or the Christmas decorations in Teguise.

In Majorca, Hipotels has three hotels that are open during this period. Two of them are located in Cala Millor, very close to Punta de n'Amer Natural Reserve which houses one of



the area's main attractions: a 17th century fortress. At **Hipocampo Playa and Hipotels Dunas Cala Millor** hotels, guests can enjoy sports activities, discover scuba diving or take a ride in a hot air balloon. If you opt for Playa de Palma, **Hipotels Playa de Palma Palace** is the ideal place for getting in some relaxation over this long weekend.

During this festive time, the island also holds the Son Amar Christmas Market in Bunyola and Christmas shows and offers an ice-skating rink. The Swedish Church of Palma organises a bazaar where you can buy Christmas decorations and taste some traditional ginger bread, cinnamon buns, and mulled wine. In addition, on 7 December, the last concert of the Jazz Voyeur Festival will be held with a gospel tribute to Aretha Franklin— an excellent opportunity to enjoy good music.

Another must-see destination over this long weekend is Cadiz, known as *La Tacita de Plata* or The Little Silver Cup. **Hipotels Barrosa Park Hotel**, located in Chiclana de la Frontera, offers relaxed luxury, a distinguishing quality of Hipotels for breaking the daily routine. Golf, tennis, paddle ball, an afternoon at the spa or a visit to Sancti Petri Island are just some of the activities guests can enjoy. In Jerez de la Frontera, **Hipotels Sherry Park** Hotel offers the chance to enjoy the wine and brandy routes and to visit the Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art. Lastly, over this long weekend a number of activities are organised such as the 9th Ruta del Ibérico in Tarifa, and the Jerez *zambombas*, traditional Christmas flamenco parties where people sing Christmas carols while drinking local wines and *pestiños*.
